109. Increase efforts to combat violence against women, such as strengthening confidence in the judiciary, as measures to prevent violence and promote services and networks for women in rural areas (Spain);	✗
127. Develop a national strategy to deal with modern slavery, including the ratification of the 2014 ILO Protocol to the Convention on Forced Labour and intensify efforts to protect rural workers and women at risk of trafficking (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland);	✗
140. Continue implementing measures to combat poverty and social inequality through the implementation of rural development plans involving vulnerable groups, particularly rural women (Sri Lanka);	✗
141. Implement additional measures to address the problems related to poverty and socioeconomic inequality among vulnerable regions and groups of the population, such as rural residents (Uzbekistan);	✗
167. Promote efforts to ensure inclusive education consistent to the parameters of the National Education Plan 2014-2024, particularly in rural areas (Morocco);	✗
172. Increase investments in educational infrastructure and raise the level of education in rural areas (China);	✗
176. Continue to implement new policies and expand the scope of existing policies to broaden gender equality, specifically for women in rural areas and low-income families (Singapore);	✗
183. Expand the "Women, Living without Violence" program, paying special attention to women and girls residing in rural areas and that are of African-Brazilian descent (Belgium);	✗
186. Strengthen measures to eliminate violence and discrimination against women and girls, particularly in rural and remote areas (Islamic Republic of Iran);	✗
